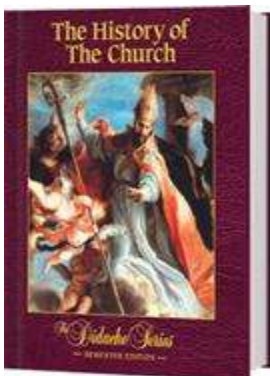
RITE OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION FOR ADULTS AND CHILDREN – WEDNESDAY EVENINGS AT 6:30 PM
